

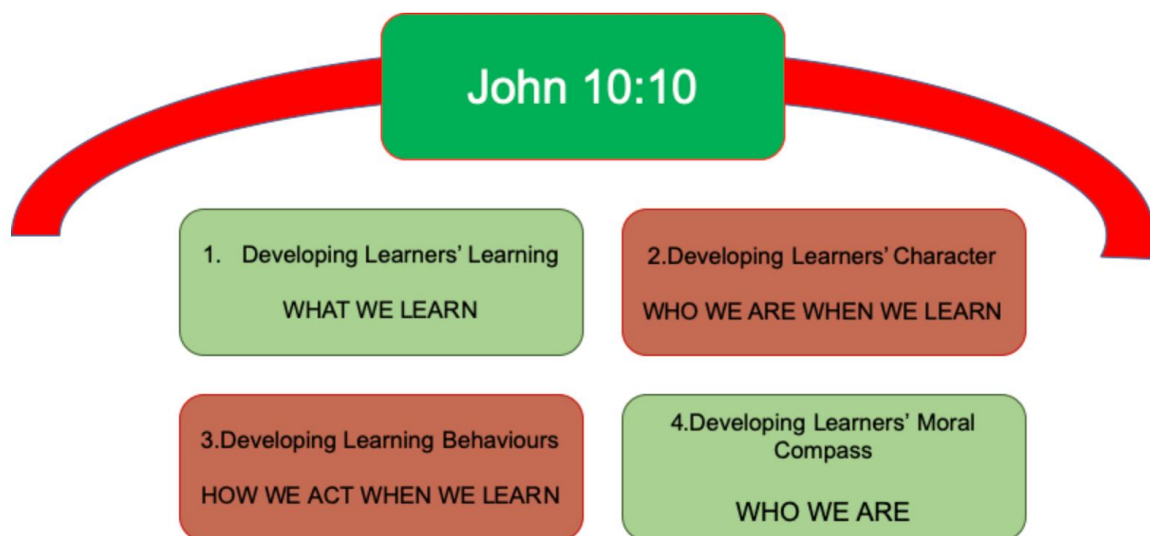


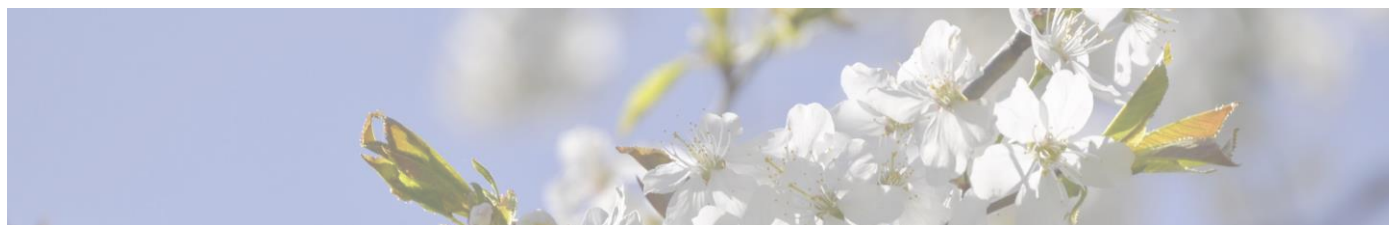
What is my child learning this half term?

Summer 2	Year 1/2
Class Novel	Swallows – Children of the throne by Joesph Coelho Robins – Kate on the Case by Hannah Peck Kingfishers- The Abominables – Eva Ibbotson
Writing	In Read, Write Inc this half term the children will continue to learn and revise their set 1, 2 and 3 sounds. In each group, they will explore a text related to their reading levels and sounds that they are learning. They will progress into composing descriptive sentences, questions, speech and thought bubbles and short narratives both orally and written. Children who have moved onto English lessons with Ms Zaki and Mr Bird will begin the half term by writing narrative poems called “If I was in Charge of the World”. They will then move on to writing stories based on the brilliant book “The Crow’s Tale”.
Maths	In Year 1 this half term, we will be finishing off our multiplication and division topic. The children will then move on to fractions, specifically halves, quarters and thirds. We will then be learning to read, write and count numbers within 100 to prepare them for their move into year 2 after the summer! In Robins, we will be continuing with all of the above! Towards the end of the year, will be recognising coins and their amounts before looking at reading the clock to ‘o’clock’ and ‘half past’ times. Year 2 children will be learning to tell and write time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. They will also learn to compare and sequence intervals of time and know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
Science	In science, we will be naming a variety of common flowering plants and observing <i>how</i> seeds and bulbs grow and <i>what</i> they need to grow.
RE	In RE, we will be exploring the learning question ‘How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?’
History	In history this term, we will be looking at the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements: Emily Davison and Rosa Parks.
PE	In PE this half term, we will start to learn the fundamentals of cricket and new athletic skills to use on sports day.
RHE	In Relationship Health Education, this term we will be learning the scientific names for the female and male body parts.

Dartington Year 1/2 Curriculum Booklet Summer 2: Year A

Forest School	In forest school, this half term the children will harvest salad leaves and edible flowers, grow beanstalks to measure and track plant growth using natural dyes.
Music	In Music, we will be exploring sound and creating a story using glockenspiels.
DT	In DT, we will be designing and making our own storyteller hand puppets! The children will learn to use two different stitch techniques (running stitch and overcast stitch), how to cut using a template, and decorate using finishing techniques.
