




## What is my child learning this half term?

Within our vision *‘together we grow, together we flourish’* our children will develop a love of learning and be totally immersed in different worlds, cultures and times preparing them for the next stage of their lives.





<b>Spr 2</b>	<b>Year 3/4</b>
<b>Class Novel</b>	Years 3 and 4 will be reading 'The Truth Pixie' in whole class reading as well as beginning to explore 'A Midsummer's Nights Dream' in preparation for World Book Day.
<b>Writing</b>	This half-term, we are focusing on writing to entertain. To start, we will be writing an adventure story based on the book 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. Throughout this term, we will be developing our grammar skills, including use of adverbials and dialogue to move a story on.
<b>Maths</b>	The Year 3 and Year 4 maths curriculum this term will cover learning on length and perimeter before moving onto fractions and decimals as well as mass and capacity for Year 3.
<b>Science</b>	We will be learning about forces and magnets. We will compare how things move, explore magnets repelling and attracting each other as well as identifying magnetic materials.
<b>RE</b>	This term we will be exploring Judaism and thinking about our big question: How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people? We will be making links from our learning to our own experiences.
<b>History</b>	In our history lessons, we will be learning all about the Romans and thinking about the impact the Roman invasion had on Britain and the Celtic people. We will be using historical sources to help us find out who they were and the reasons why they invaded Britain. We will also be discovering who Boudica was and why her rebellion was important.
<b>PE</b>	For our PE lessons this term, we will be focusing on Dance and Tag Rugby. We will be outside for our lessons where possible, so please ensure all children have suitable PE kits at all times.
<b>RHE</b>	Our RHE learning will explore 'Media, Literacy and Digital Resilience' as well moving on to think about 'Money and Work'.
<b>Forest School</b>	In Forest School this half term, we will be working in the vegetable patch so we are prepared and ready for harvesting later in the year.
<b>Music</b>	This half-term, we will be exploring the work of 'The Beatles' with a focus on the song 'Blackbird' which is a song about the civil rights movement. The children will be focusing on pulse and rhythm during this unit of work.
<b>DT</b>	This half-term, our focus will be exploring and designing an illuminated sign. We will build our knowledge of electrical circuits to make and evaluate our own versions.
