Where do I go?

- For most classes, please enter via the paddock gate (side gate) and make your way straight to the main hall, where you will meet your child's class and the exhibition will be held.
- For the final session (Goldfinches and Red Kites), please enter via the main gate and go directly to your child's classroom where the class teacher will walk their class and parents around to the other entrance to the hall.

All children will return to their classrooms to be collected as usual after at 3.15pm. You are very welcome to return for our Open Classrooms event at 2.30pm.
