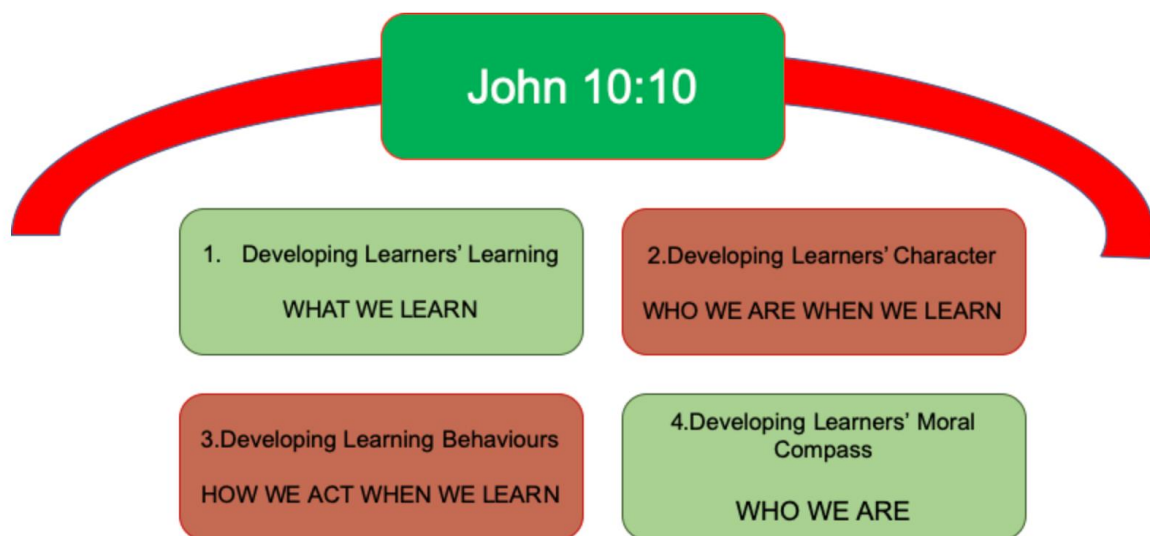


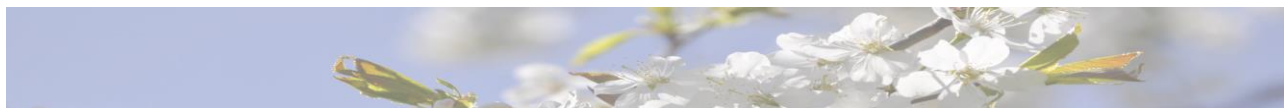
## What is my child learning this half term?

Our curriculum is the beating heart of our school and is

Within our vision '*together we grow, together we flourish*'  
our children will develop a love of learning and be totally  
immersed in different worlds, cultures and times preparing  
them for the next stage of their lives.





<b>Summer 2</b>	<b>Tawny Owls, Nightingales and Woodpeckers</b>
<b>Class Novel</b>	Each class will be voting to decide on their own class novel for the term. These will be age-appropriate and an opportunity for the children to have more of a choice in the novel they listen to at the end of the day.
<b>Writing</b>	Over the next six weeks, we will be “writing to entertain”. We will be immersing ourselves in Greek myths and time travel stories while practising and honing our authorial skills.
<b>Maths</b>	This half term, Year 3 & 4 will be learning about money and statistics. We will also focus on times tables with daily sessions as well as maths fluency with arithmetic questions.
<b>Science</b>	Our science topic this term is exploring electricity – we’ll explore what electricity is, how it’s generated, and how it’s used in everyday life. We’ll learn about circuits, conductors, insulators, and electrical safety.
<b>RE</b>	Our RE question for this half term is “How and why do people mark the significant events of life?” We’ll be linking our learning about different religions to explore similarities and differences.
<b>History</b>	In history, we are going to be comparing life in Stone Age Britain compared to Iron Age Britain. We’ll use a range of sources to explore pre-historic life.
<b>PE</b>	Our Saints South West PE will be athletics skills – we’ll be preparing for Sports Day with javelin throwing, long jumping and relay running.
<b>RHE</b>	<p>In RHE this half-term our children will be exploring the statutory unit of learning based upon ‘Changing and Growing’ – we’ll be using scientific language and age-appropriate resources to support our learning.</p> <p>(Due to an error, Woodpeckers were taught this content in Summer 1. As such, they will be covering the RHE content from the Summer 1 and will be learning about mental wellbeing and physical health.)</p>
<b>Forest School</b>	This term, we’ll be preparing our gardening area for our autumnal growing activities. We’ll be doing lots of weeding and preparation work to ensure the best growing environment. We’ll continue to also build our collaboration and teamwork skills using nature based crafts and activities.
<b>Music</b>	In music, we’ll be using glockenspiels and our voices to create chords and improvise using ‘The Doot Doot’ song.
<b>Computing</b>	We will be learning about programming using the online platform Scratch. We will investigate controls and events.
<b>French</b>	This term, we’re going to explore sports. We’ll be learning how to pronounce and discuss different sports that we enjoy.
<b>DT</b>	In DT we will be practicing our skills with food. We’ll be exploring varied and balanced diets to ensure we are able to understand healthy choices. We’ve linked our DT with a school visit to enable us to cook a healthy meal using farm fresh ingredients.
